The historic centre of Padova (Padua) is dominated by the imposing Palazzo della Ragione, which was built in the year 1218. We will visit the ancient covered market "Sotto il Salone" famous since the past because it is the heaven of food ...you will taste asiago cheese, mezzano, parmiggiano reggiano, burrata cheese, salami, prosciutto crudo to end with a spritz, typical drink from the Veneto region with aperol and prosecco or with a glass of red wine!

From the hotel we will reach the medieval squares - <u>Piazza dei Signori, Piazza delle Erbe, Piazza della Frutta</u> – seat of the daily market which have been representing one of the most beloved meeting points of the Paduan for the last 800 years. Nearby there is the old University of Padua, estabilished in 1222.

It is one of the oldest in the world and keeps several places of great historical value:the anatomy teatre (1594), which is the oldest in the world,the 14<sup>th</sup> century Medicine room, Galilei's chair and the Aula Magna. In its ancient and glorious University fundamental contributions to the progress of science and technology have been made thanks to the presence of enlightened and ingenious personalities.

We will end the tour tasting the famous "caffè alla menta e cacao", coffee with mint and cocoa at the historical Caffe Pedrocchi. where Galileo use to come and meet colleges and students. <u>The Pedrocchi Café</u> is a <u>café</u> founded in the 18th century in central <u>Padua</u>.

### • <u>SCROVEGNI CHAPEL</u> 1 hour

It was Giotto, in the first years of the Trecento, to give impulse to fresco decoration and narrative painting and the <u>The Scrovegni Chapel (1303-1305)</u> is considered the <u>greatest masterpiece of fourteen Italian and European painting.</u> Under a blue, starry heaven, it illustrates the life of Mary, Jesus and the story of the Passion.

"Enoteca" is an <u>Italian</u> word, derived from the Greek which literally means "wine repository", case, box), but is used to describe a special type of local or regional wine bar where is possible to taste wines and little apetizers.

### BASILICA of SAINT ANTHONY +BOTANICAL GARDEN –

<u>Saint Anthony Basilica</u>,locally called II Santo, holds the mortal remain of Saint Anthony. The sanctuary is a real shrine of art and devotion.

A Short distance away you can visit the <u>University Botanical Garden</u>, one of the oldest in the World which also a UNESCO HERITAGE SITE

#### WINE, HONEY AND TRADITIONAL FOOD in ARQUA' PETRARCA

In the Euganean hills of Padua, REGIONAL PARK since 1989, the climate is particularly mild and allows extensive wine and oil-growing with excellent results: there are a full 13 D.O.C wines (Denomination of Controlled Origin) including the well -known Cabernet Franc, Ssauvignon, Chardonnay, Serprino and Moscato Fior d'Arancio. Other typical products of the hills are honey, cheese and seasonal fruits (chestnuts, cherries, peas and jujubes).

**Honey** is produced both in the Millefiori(obtained from different types of flowers) and in the one-flower variety, in particular acacia and chestnuts honey.







The gem of the hills is the medieval village of **Arquà Petrarca**, where time seems to stand still, keeping the magic of the Middle Ages intact.

Its peaceful atmosphere attracted and inspire the great Italian poet Francesco Petrarca, who spent here the last years of his life (14<sup>th</sup> century). His house, retains original ceiling and furniture. The beauty of this hills has attacted and inspired generations of poets, writers and artist, from the provencal troubandours, who gathered at the Estensi court in the 12<sup>th</sup> century to the most Italian and foreign writers of the past century such as Byron,Shelley, Foscolo.

### AMARONE WINE TOUR in VALPOLICELLA (hills in Verona)





Valpolicella is the hilly region north-west of Verona between Verona and Lake Garda, one hour far from Venice.

The name Valpolicella has probably Roman origins in\_latin "vallis polis cellae" means\_"valley of the many cellars", proving the ancient wine making tradition of this area.

Valpolicella is known all over the world for its famous wines, especially the Amarone, Recioto, Ripasso.

Its territory is made of beautiful landscapes, sweet hills that become mountains as you move north, valleys with old **villages**, , medieval **churches**, making it a tourist destination in its own.

'Ripasso' literally means 'revision', 'ri-pass', 'go over again' and is an old technique used by Valpolicella winemakers to enrich the normal Valpolicella wine with the flavors of the Amarone. After harvest, depending on the year in september or october, the best grapes selected for the production of the amarone are left to dry for four months in special drying lofts above wineries called "fruttaio". The other grapes are squeezed soon after harvest and fermented to make the normal Valpolicella wine. At the beginning of february, the semi-dried grapes for the production of Amarone are also squeezed and fermented.

At the end of the wine making process, Amarone is then put in **oak barrels** for the **ageing.** Fermentation tanks, with the **skins** of the semi-dried grapes used for the production of the Amarone are then refilled with the fresh Valpolicella wine produced in Autumn.

It is an infusion, we could almost say an "Amarone tea" in which some of the flavor and alcohol of the Amarone transfer to the wine. The resulting Valpolicella Ripasso is a medium body wine, which stands between the normal Valpolicella and the Amarone.





#### We will visit two vineyard

Located in the heart of Valpolicella Classica, the ancient sandstone quarry, dating back to the 15th century, testifies to the intimate interrelationship between the vineyard's philosophy and its local corner of earth.

This underground complex, irresistibly fascinating and radiating an utterly distinctive genius loci, provides unique continuity between the past of tradition and the future of innovation.

As the locus where nature, culture, and history converge, the quarry serves as the very foundation stone of the vineyard its bodily structure fashioned of natural stone, the magical cavern in which, year after year, the wines mature, then finally enter the bottle.





And finally, the "bottaia", which hosts the botti", or large ovals of the finest European oak, a space powerfully enhanced by a wall of naked stone "on edge," its extraction marks and stratified limestone creating a contemporary feel.



#### 2nd Vineyard

Escaping Florence, where he had sentenced to death for political reasons, <u>Dante Alighieri</u> arrived in Verona in 1312 where he stayed, under the protection of Cangrande of the <u>Scala family</u>, until 1318. In 1353 Pietro Alighieri, first son of the great poet, acquired the property of **Casal dei Ronchi** 



in **Gargagnago**, in the heart of the traditional **Valpolicella Classica** production area.

In 1549 Ginevra Alighieri, descendant of Dante's family, married **Marcantonio Serego**, member of a noble and powerful family of Verona. Through the centuries the family enlarged the property of Casal dei Ronchi with new acquisitions. Agriculture and viticulture continued to be the most important family business.

They produce all main Valpolicella wines, especially an excellent Amarone that, after a two years aging in oak barrels, spends other four month in cherry wood barrels. Serego Alighieri winery can be visited in the historical Casal dei Ronchi complex. In the wine shop full of atmosphere can be tasted all the Serego-Alighieri and Masi products, not only the famous Valpolicella wines, also extra virgin olive oil, rice and jams.





The third vineyard is a leading producer in the Valpolicella Classica area and one of the most highly-regarded and award-winning Italian wineries in the world.

Owned by the an ancient family, which has had roots in the Valpolicella since the sixteenth century, the Company has over 100 hectares of hillside vineyards in the Classico zone.

### PROSECCO WINE TOUR





A few kilometers from Venice you will find the Altamarca Trevigiana corresponding to the foothills of the Veneto Region, north of the city of Treviso. Amphiteatre of the Venice lagoon and passage towards the Dolomites of Cortina d'Ampezzo, it is a gem nestled between Asolo , Conegliano and Valdobbiadene.

In this area in 1966, was born the first wine route in Italy: the *Prosecco and Colli di Conegliano and Valdobbiadene Wine Road* which goes through landscape of nature, art and taste.

Thanks to its unmistakable variety and fruity aroma, different from any other sparkling wine, it succeded in meeting the taste of modern consumers.

Pleasant with a natural but strong sweet edge, this versatile and polyhedral wine easily matches any international dish.











An experience that must absolutely be tried: the fragrances of vintages past that the cellar treasures and then releases, testifying to the years during which selections mature and solutions emerge. One must witness the places where the grape answers its nature and transforms itself into wine. Once ripeness comes, it prepares for a new future, a process perfected through the years, one that expert eyes must follow with meticulous attention, a path that step by step leads to a wine that is controlled and guaranteed.

In Ettore's cellar, the enthusiasm for this journey increases in degrees with each new year, while tradition and innovation strengthen their partnership, in order to express, with quality wines. From the picking of the clusters during the harvest, then through the entire vinification process in the cellar, the grapes are carefully stewarded, step by step, to ensure the highest quality in each bottle.

Red and white wines, sweet and sparkling, all capable of capturing the attention of the most demanding palates.







Splendid Palladian style villa dating back to 1622, is located in a renowned winemaking area in the heart of the province of Treviso. Three century old underground cellars stretch for over 1,5 km under the villa and create the perfect environment for wine aging.

Visitors are guided on a tour through the historical underground cellars through galleries dating back to the First World War that lead right to the living room of the Villa.

At the end of the tour will be served a tasting of Prosecco wine.

The owner purchased the nineteenth-century farmhouse years ago, along with a total of nearly 30 hectares of land. By the time a few years had passed, he had created a model wine-producing company, founded according to careful plans and research. Next to the unique bright-red house, Giovanni Rui created a modern, functional cellar, which, in part, is terraced into the hillside. Equipped with up-to-date techniques, it is often visited by students from the Ecological Institute and university students from Conegliano who are earning a degree Enology.

Sommelier delegations and amateur wine-tasters also visit to learn more about the company's wines and study its modern, efficient management.

### GRAPPA TASTING IN BASSANO DEL GRAPPA AND MAROSTICA





Bassano Del Grappa is located north of Vicenza and is one of the larger cities within the Vicenza Province. This geographical location has made Bassano a strategic land point for thousands of years, controlling the flow of migrating people from the North and South. The city was first established as an army camp, by the Romans, and from that time forward it has played a significant role in local history, history that we may be acquainted with but do not realize that it originated in this unique area.

The area of Bassano has been inhabited since the paleo-venetian period. The settlement was colonized by the Romans in the early part of the 1<sup>st</sup> century and by the 2<sup>nd</sup>century had assumed the name a major Roman land owner. The name Bassano derives form the Roman family Basius, who were owner so large "latifundium", owned property. This family owned or controlled the land the town Bassano was built upon. Up until the early 1900's the town was known as Bassano Veneto.

**Bridge of the Alpini (symbol of the city)** is first mentioned in history during the medieval city dates from 998, while the Castle is mentioned first in 1150. In 1175 Bassano was conquered by Vicenza, but the city maintained a semi-autonomous status as a free commune in the 13th century even when it was under the rule of the Ezzelino family.



As mentioned above, today the symbol of the town is the covered wooden pontoon bridge 'Ponte Alpini', which is said to have been rebuilt following the-designed by the architect Andrea Palladio in 1569. The bridge has been destroyed many times, the most recent was-during WWII. The Alpine soldier's organization or Alpini have based a large part of their historical pride on the battles of WWI that occurred around wooden bridge and Bassano Del Grappa.

The Museo della

Grappa "Jacopo Poli" is located in 15th-century Palazzo delle Teste. The museum was created by the Poli family, who own the distillery (dates from 1898). The exhibitions focus on the history of grappa-distilling since it first began, showing how methods have changed; the production cycle of grappa, from the grape-harvest until the grappa comes out of the still. The library has a fine collection of antique and more recent specialist books on the subject. One of the most important is a volume entitled 'Liber de arte distillandi' by Hieronymus Brunschwigh (1500), the first book ever printed on the subject of grappa.



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Upon availability it will be possible to visit the new modern distillery of the in Bassano area.



The Riviera del Brenta, which extends over an area between the provinces of Venice and Padua is famous all over the world for its historical villas and for luxury shoes production, for both man and women.

During our short trip from Venice (20 minutes), we will pass by Villa Foscari known as "La Malcontenta" the only one built by the famous architect Palladio Unesco Heritage Site since 1993 and Villa Pisani, a National Museum.

The craft tradition that gave birth to one of Italy's most prestigious manufacturing sectors began in the distant past, thirteenth century, originating from the "Calegheri



shoemakers, who accompanied Venetian nobles to their villas in the venetian country side (The Brenta Riviera). Virtually all designer footwear sold in stores around the world is now produced, co-designed and marketed by the shoe factories on the Riviera del Brenta.
